

BENEFITS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERSHIP

BENEFITS OF ACTIVE MEMBERS

- Eligible to apply for solo show.
- Enter work for group or theme shows other than the Associates Show.
- Submit work to website.
- Have a current bio and CDs or photos of work in Gallery's presentation book.
- Store five works in Gallery bins. (This work is matted and covered in plastic.)
- May hold office and vote at monthly board meeting.

BENEFITS OF ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

- Eligible to enter work for New Members Show.
- Enter work for December Holiday Show, Associates Show and one additional show per year.
- Submit work to website.
- Have a current bio and CDs or photos of work in Gallery's presentation book.
- Work on committees and attend monthly meetings.
- Welcome to re-submit work for active status jurying in fall or spring.

OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTICIPATE

- All members are welcome to attend any demonstrations, studio tours or membership meetings. Check newsletter for current information.
- All members are encouraged to attend and participate in all Gallery board meetings, held in the Gallery usually on the second Monday of the month at 7:00 PM.
- All members are encouraged to attend all openings and shows in the Gallery.

OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE

Members demonstrate their commitment to the Guild with volunteer service:

- Working on Community Outreach Program
- Demonstrating techniques in special programs
- Receiving, installing or removing artwork for shows
- Staffing the Gallery
- Serving on committees for events including auctions and fundraisers
- Providing computer, clerical and marketing skills

Each member is required to volunteer ten hours of service per year. This can be waived for a \$50 fee.

ART SALES

All work exhibited and kept for inventory must be for sale. Members set the sale price for each piece. When artwork is sold the member receives 65% of the selling price and the Guild receives 35%.

ANNUAL DUES

Active Members: \$185.

Associate Members: 125.

Initiation fee: 50.
